- **Private Sector Bank Unions' Cell meeting at Mangalore on 27-6-2025**
- **Successful Conference of All India Karnataka Bank Employees Association**

After the last meeting of our Cell held at Nainital on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2024, a meeting of the Cell was held in Mangalore on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2025. Com. K G Paneendra, General Secretary of All India Karnataka Bank Employees Association and Chairman of our cell presided over the meeting. Com. C H Venkatachalam, General Secretary of AIBEA, Com M Jayanath, Joint Secretary of AIBEA, Com. M S Srinivasan, President, KPBEF and Com Chandrasekar, Secretary, KPBEF participated in our meeting and guided the deliberations.

Com. Paneendra, Chairman, narrated the background in which the meeting was taking place and the present challenges before the private sector Banks. He also welcomed all the participants to attend the Conference of All India Karnataka Bank Employees Association.

The Convener reported about the developments after the last meeting. He

informed that the attacks in Tamilnadu Mercantile Bank have since been amicably resolved since management has closed the issue without further proceedings. He also informed that in Nainital Bank, no further steps have been taken for selling the shares by BOB to some private investors. He informed the developments in Federal Bank and the discussions held with the management. He informed that due our persuasion and intervention of AIBEA, the ex-gratia amount for the pensioners has been released with retrospective effect. He further informed that during the recent period, Conferences have been held by our unions in Karur Vysya Bank, HDFC Bank and Federal Bank introduced the newly elected leaders.

Representatives from all the unions reported on the developments in their respective Bank. The meeting was also addressed by Com C H Venkatachalam, Com M Jayanath and Com M S Srinivasan. Com CHV assured that AIBEA will continue to extend all support to the issues and demands of our Unions in Private Banks. He explained the implications of the present scenario in the context of the policies being pursued by the Government. He exhorted all our Unions to make the ensuing nationwide general strike on 9<sup>th</sup> July a total success in the private banks.

After discussions, the following decisions were taken:

- i To effectively implement the strike on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2025**
- ii Membership of our Unions to be further strengthened.**
- iii To demand release of Ex gratia to pensioners in all other Banks**
- iv To demand amicable solution to victimisation in Federal Bank**
- v Recruitment in the Banks**
- vi Wage revision in CSB Bank**
- vii Stop selling IDBI Bank to private corporate companies**

It was decided that to highlight and pursue these issues and demands, a Dharna to be organised before Parliament in Delhi during the ensuing Parliament session. Details of this programme will be decided and finalised

shortly in consultation with the leadership of AIBEA. Com. CHV assured that all support to this programme will be given by AIBEA.

**Conference of All India Karnataka Bank Employees Association :** The 26<sup>th</sup> Conference of AIBEA was held on 27<sup>th</sup> evening and 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2025. The conference was participated by more than 1200 delegates and observers and hence was a massive success. The Conference elected Com Girish as President and re-elected Com K G Paneendra as the General Secretary. We convey our good wishes to the new team of office bearers.
