OUR 36th ALL INDIA CONFERENCE @ CHENNAI – A RESOUNDING SUCCESS

The 36th All India conference of our Union was held at Chennai on 28th & 29th December 2019 with massive participation of members working in various branches across India with more participation from young comrades. The entire vicinity of the conference hall was adorned with AIBEA festoons. Com.D. Arumugam, President of our Union hoisted the AIBEA flag amidst thunderous slogans.

The inaugural session commenced at 10.00 a.m. Com.S.D. Srinivasan, Chairman of the Reception Committee welcomed all the members. Com.D. Arumugam, President of the Union delivered his Presidential speech.

Com.C.H. Venkatachalam, General Secretary of All India Bank Employees' Association inaugurated the conference. In his inaugural address, he highlighted the issues that are confronted by the bank employees today due to the neo-liberal policies pursued by the central government and how it affects the working class and the banking industry. He requested the members to fully take part in the all India strike on 8.1.2020 and make it a success. He also spoke on the latest developments in the ongoing 11th bi-partite settlement.

Sri.J. Natarajan, President & COO of our Bank was the Chief Guest of the conference. In his speech he expressed his happiness to participate in the conference. He stated that management would look into the various issues given by the union and requested the members to fully take part in the growth and development of the bank.

Com.E. Arunachalam, General Secretary, Tamilnadu Bank Employees' Federation delivered his special address. He spoke on the present day situation prevailing in the banking industry, the move of the central government to merge public sector banks, rising NPAs in the banking industry, challenges faced by the old private sector banks from the new generation banks etc.

Com.P. Mathew George, Joint Convener, Private Sector Banks' Union Cell and General Secretary of Federal Bank Employees' Union addressed our members. He spoke at length about the present situation the old private sector banks are facing, need to have move coordination among the unions in the old Private Sector Banks etc.

Co.M. Narasimhan, General Secretary, Karur Vysya Bank Officers' Association and Com.J. Rajendran, General Secretary, Karur Vysya Bank Retirees' Association offered their felicitations.

The dignitaries were honoured with shawl and memento by the Reception Committee members.

Com.l. Venkatesan, General Secretary proposed vote of thanks and the inaugural session concluded by 2.00 p.m.

Delegate Session: The General Secretary report was presented by Com.I. Venkatesan in the delegate session. Many comrades mostly youngsters spoke on the report. They have effectively articulated their view points on various issues that they are facing at the branches and requested the union to address those issues by taking up the same with the management. After replying to the deliberations, the General Secretary Report was adopted unanimously by the General Body amidst thunderous applause.

The accounts of the Union was presented by the Treasurer Com.A. Srinivasan and the same was adopted unanimously.

On 29th December '2019 morning Justice K. Chandru, Retired Judge, High Court of Madras delivered his special address. He dealt at length the labour law amendments made by the Central Government and how it will affect the working class of the country. He said that bank employees must align with the working class of this country in opposing the wrong policies of the government that is affecting the working class and the common people of the country. His hour long speech was heard with rapt attention by the delegates.

Honouring former office bearers of our Union: As part of the Diamond Jubilee year of our Union, we have invited former Office Bearers of our Union to the Conference. The leaders were adorned with shawl and honoured in the conference.

Various delegates and leaders spoke about the multi faced personality of Com.Srinivasan and wished them happy and healthy retired life.
