Dear Comrades,

Com.P. Narasimha Rao, our Vice-President retires from the services of the Bank on 30th November, 2020.

Com.P. Narasimha Rao, fondly called as Com.PNR our union Vice-President and one of the senior most members of our Union and a leader in Andhra Pradesh and Telengana is retiring from the services of the Bank on 30th November, 2020 after putting in more than 40 years of service. Born to late Sri.Pachipulusu Aadhi Seasaiah and late Smt.Rangamma, Com.Narasimha Rao had his school education in Prodattur. Due to the untimely demise of his father and in order to take care his family members, he was forced to discontinue his further school education and search for a job. Our Bank had given him the employment. In the year 1978, he joined our Bank as casual labour in our Prodattur branch and in the year 1980 he was regularized in the services of the Bank as Sub-staff. After joining our bank he pursued his higher education and completed his graduation. In the year 1988, he was promoted as Clerk and posted in our Nellore branch.

In Nellore branch, he had the opportunity of working along with Com.J. Hemachandra Rao, former Organising Secretary of our Union who later held the position of President of KVBOA, Com.G.Shyamsundar our former Vice-President and got inspired with their trade union activities. After few years he was again transferred back to his native place Prodattur. His trade union journey started in the year 1995 in our conference held at Chennai where he was elected as Executive Committee Member representing Cuddaph - Prodattur area. In our Tirupathi conference held in January 1998, he was elected as Organising Secretary representing Andhra Pradesh and in our Trichy conference held in December 2016, he was elevated to the post of Vice-President which post he is holding till date.

Com.Narasimha Rao is basically an organizational man and will carry out whatever task entrusted to him by the union leadership. In January 1998, our union conducted its all India conference in Tirupathi. In those days, we had very few branches in and around Tirupathi area. Membership is also not that much large in that area for conducting an all India conference. However, Com.Narasimha Rao who was Executive Committee Member of that area along with Com.Shyamsundar former Vice-President of our Union and other active cadres have successfully conducted the conference in the Temple city much to the appreciation of all. Also Com.Narasimha Rao fully involved himself along with other union functionaries and activists in successfully conducting various meetings held in important centres in Andhra Pradesh and Telengana during this period.

Com.Narasimha Rao is not a big orator but always voiced his opinions with very strong conviction. In all the Office Bearer / Executive Committee meetings, he used to put forth his opinion without any reservations. He has attended the conferences of our AIBEA, APTBEF as Delegate and also a regular participant in the various Delhi Chalo programmes organized by our AIBEA.

Com.Narasimha would used to say that he always cherishes his association with the Union and had it not been KVBEU he would not have had the opportunity of deriving pleasure by working for the society at large. He also used to acknowledge the role played by our senior leaders Com.J. Rajendran former President, Com.V. Krishnamurthy former General Secretary, late Com.K. Chandrasekara Rao, former Vice-President, Com.G. Shyamsundar, former Vice-President and other leaders in making him as a front line trade union activist. He has taken lot of efforts in identifying new cadres.

Com.Narasimha Rao did not confine his trade union activities in KVBEU alone. He is popular among bank employees in Prodattur town and was the President of Prodattur Town Bank Employees' Co-ordination Committee till the year 2017 when he was transferred to Cuddapah branch on non-request. In Cuddapah also, he fully involved in the local bank employees movement and was elected as Joint Secretary of Cuddapah District Bank Employees' Co-ordination Committee.

Married to Smt.Nalini the couple is blessed with two daughters and a son and all are settled in life. At this juncture, we thank Smt.Nalini and her children for extending their support and co-operation to Com.Narasimha Rao which enabled him to function successfully as a functionary of our union.

Comrades, this Leader is retiring from the services of the Bank on 30th November '2020. Com.Narasimha Rao joined as a casual labour had risen to occupy the post of the Vice-President in our Union through his commitment and dedicated his entire career for KVBEU. Many young comrades have now joined our Bank and our Union. They should know that there is a world apart from the one usually preferred and that is working for the trade union movement. This is the message we have to inherit from this Comrade. He is retiring only from the services of the bank and not from the hearts of our Members.

On behalf of the members of KVBEU, we wish Com.Narasimha Rao a happy and healthy retired life. We also wish him to continue his services for the working class movement of this country.
